The NEBOSH IGC is divided into three units. Were unit 1 or IGC1 and unit 2 or IGC2 required classroom examinations and the unit 3 or IGC3 is basically a practical examination or preparation of inspection report that can be carried out in your own workplace or at home. Unit-1 is about management of international health and safety, unit-2 focuses on control of international workplace hazards and unit-3 is the practical applications where you can apply what you've learn from unit-1 and unit-2. Syllabus and sample examination papers usually provided by the training provider and some previous examination papers were also provided but remember that those references aren't contain the actual examination answers but it will guide students to analyze how does or what the NEBOSH examiners look for when checking examination paper and submitted report.

**NOTE**: Once you've pass the NEBOSH IGC your credentials will be upgraded, it will level-up your qualification, your skills and ability on preparing safety reports will be more effective, your speed

on analyzing and resolving safety related problem in the workplace will improve a lot. This is what I am experiencing now and I know you want to experience it too, right?
